## NSW companies seal deals with China

TWO New South Wales based businesses are the latest to take advantage of the NSW Business Chamber's Export Growth China program, by signing major MOU's with Chinese companies.

The deals were signed on the final day of the Australia Week in China activities in Shanghai.

Present to witness the deal were former Trade Minister and now special envoy Andrew Robb MP, and the President of the NSW Business Chamber, Professor Trevor Cairney, OAM.

The first deal was between Sydney's Nova Spring Water and Chinese leading retailer T3C; the other was between Phoenix International Exports, an Australian company famous for its premium cow and goat milk powder, and ShangGang, one of the 500 largest companies in China.

"This is great news for these two Australian companies, and a great reward for all of their hard work in trying to crack into this market," NSW Business Chamber CEO Stephen Cartwright said.
